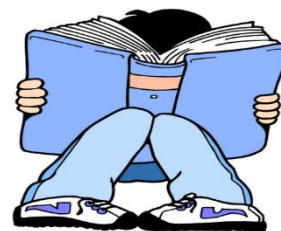


# Reading Challenge

## Rewards

If 8 books are read, your child will gain the **Silver** award (80 Reading Points)

If 10 books are read, your child will gain the **Gold** award (100 Reading Points)

For each book completed, your child will earn 10 reading points

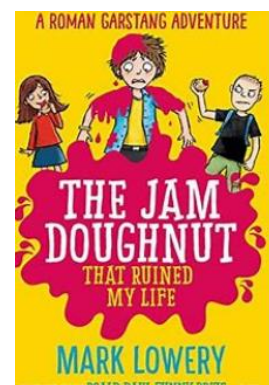
