Appointed by: Pupils in their own house, Headteacher, KS2 lead
Responsible to: KS2 Lead

Objectives:

- To instil leadership quality in children
- To have students representatives in school management system
- To be positive role models
- To act as bridge between students and school management
- To develop sense of responsibilities among themselves

The role:

1. To act as a role model for students
2. To be friendly and positive
3. To encourage children particularly within own house
4. To meet ad hoc requests for assistance from house staff
5. To perform monitor duties on a specified days. E.g. sports day, good to be green days, house competitions
6. To work together with other house captains
7. To support with the organisation of school events
8. To lead prayers during house collective worship
9. To make speeches to own house
