Objectives:

- To instil leadership quality in children
- To have students representatives in school management system.
- To involve students in making plans and policy of the school
- To act as bridge between students and school management

The role:

1. To act as a role model for students
2. To provide a positive public profile for the children, especially at formal events.
3. To ensure prospective parents are provided with a tour of the classroom/school as requested
4. To meet ad hoc requests for assistance from senior staff
5. To perform monitor duties on a specified day
6. To take leadership roles at meetings of the School Council to manage specific projects
7. To support with the organisation of school events including Christmas Dinner
8. To lead prayers during collective worship
9. To make speeches at school events
10. To attend a range of school events, with responsibilities agreed with the Headteacher
