- Communicate between home and school through letters, newsletters, email, Google classroom and the school website.

Parent

I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- If my child is unwell or shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I (or another designated contact) will collect my child from school with 20 minutes.
- My household will adhere to the distancing guidance as set out by the Government.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child.
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully.
- I will not be allowed into the school without a prearranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- I need to read all communications that are sent home.
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed unsafe with regards to their behaviour and following of the expectations, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.
- ✤ I need to provide fresh clothing daily for my child.

Child

I will do my best to:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground.
- ✤ Tell an adult if I feel unwell.
- Not bring things into school from home, nor take things home from school.
- Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other.
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated door or gate.
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (Catch it, Bin it, Kill it).
- Follow good hand hygiene: use soap and water to wash my hands for 20 seconds/use hand sanitiser.
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others.
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
- Wear clean clothes to school every day
