INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT (made in accordance with s.20 Education Act 2002 as amended)

- 1. The name of the school is Purley Church of England Primary School.
- 2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
- 3. The name of the Governing Body is 'The Governing Body of Purley Church of England Primary School'.
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) two parent governors
 - (b) one LA governor
 - (c) one staff governor
 - (d) one headteacher
 - (e) two foundation governors
 - (f) five co-opted governors
- 5. Total number of governors shall be 12.
- 6. The name of the foundation body entitled to appoint foundation governors is The Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
- 7. The school has a trust deed dated 16th February 1875.
- 8. The ethos statement of the school is as follows:

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at Parish and Diocesan levels.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

- 9. This instrument of government comes into effect on 13th November 2013.
- 10. This instrument was made by order of West Berkshire Local Authority on 7th November 2013.
- 11. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor) and the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
